Front Entrance

Our front entrance is getting a face lift! You may have already noticed some much needed clean-up has begun around our beautiful brick wall at the main entrance of the neighborhood. You will see more changes coming as we address some drainage, lighting and planting issues. Larger letters have been installed! We have contracted with a landscaper to replant and spruce up our main entrance flowerbed three times a year! Special thanks to Board MemberKathy Thompson (Woodland Ridge Blvd) for years of weeding, cleaning and decorating the main entrance.

No Solicitation

All paperwork has been filed with the parish officially making Woodland Ridge a "No Solicitation" subdivision! No Solicitation signage is at each of the four entrances to the subdivision and Woodland Ridge is now listed on the official list of Baton Rouge No Solicitation Subdivisions. Please note Religious, political, or charitable solicitation is not considered to be peddling and is allowed.

Traffic Updates

In December's newsletter we shared road and bridge updates with you. We understand from Ingolf A. Partenheimer, Chief Traffic Engineer Department of Transportation and Drainage/Traffic Engineering Division City of Baton Rouge, that the temporary striping of Woodland Ridge Blvd and Newcastle scheduled for December did not happen due to inclement weather. We understand the NEW temporary striping of Woodland Ridge Blvd & Newcastle will happen. At this point we have not been given a date. In an effort to SLOW down traffic, the city is implementing a traffic calming measure. Striping of the boulevard will include a parking lane creating a narrower roadway encouraging drivers to SLOW down. Newcastle will have a center dividing line. The city will reconstruct our Jones Creek Bridge in 2018. We understand the Bridge will be CLOSED for a period of time but the time frame is yet to be determined.

Sign Improvements

Look for more sign improvement! The board has voted to add a Woodland Ridge sign to the neighborhood entrance at Millbrook. Various board members have volunteered to repair and clean the WR entrance sign at Afton Oaks and build the new sign for Millbrook entrance using the brass letters from the main entrance sign!

Keeping up our beautiful oaks is an important feature of our neighborhood. All dead azaleas will also be removed from the boulevard and the trees will have mulched placed around them.
